SCHOOL UPDATE

MANA hosted a meeting at the Martin Park Elementary School Gym on April 25, from 7:00 to 9:30 PM to discuss the Boulder Valley School District proposal to close or consolidate schools, including Martin Park. Approximately 50 people attended, including City Council members Don Mock and Spense Havlick, who are on the council sub-committee to address this issue, and who both addressed the group. Several other speakers contributed, followed by a general discussion.

A School Consolidation Position document from MANA was drafted at this meeting, and it was decided at the Steering Committee meeting on June 1 that it be sent to the City Council, the school board, and other neighborhood associations.

SCHOOL CONSOLIDATION GROUP FORMING



Sometime in August Moorhead Drive will be resurfaced. Table Mesa is undergoing some work involving burying of cable, but is not slated for repaving this summer.




