May MANA Meeting

Three representatives from the Center for Resource Conservation (CRC) attended and explained their services and informed us about things we could do to save on water consumption, power use and that we should recycle more. Example – sixty five per cent of constuction debri could be recycled.

Another note – fifty five per cent of residential water is used outside on lawns.
