CAN RULES

It has been brought to our attention that some of our neighbors do not know the City ordinance for trash cans.

Here it is:

On Trash pickup day, cans should be set out after 5:00 AM and taken in before 9:00PM and stored a minimum of 25' from the curb on non pickup days. If you want to report someone that is in noncompliance call the Environmental and Zoning Enforcement Supervisor, Brett Weideman @ 303/441-3239

First call is a warning, There is a fine for the second call.
