**The Steering Committee** The next meeting will be in August 1, after the summer break.

Many of us have increases in our real estate assessments and taxes despite the flat housing prices over the last few years. Be sure to review this information and decide if you want to protest or not. Typically these assessments have always lagged the market.

Over occupancy and Martin Acres: There are many four and five bedroom houses that are fully occupied by our student neighbors. Sometimes these houses are notable for excessive parking, poor appearance, and unruly activities. Some of us realize that these houses are rented at a high price and consequently become unaffordable for families to be part of our community. The law is three unrelated people per house in Martin Acres. The City of Boulder does not proactively enforce this law and depends on neighbors to make complaints.

Capital investment group: Leslie Brown, one of our neighbors, has been appointed to a city of Boulder study group and will be reporting to the steering committee over the next few months.

**Bastille Day** celebration will be at Martin Park on July 14. This is an informal gathering to share food and fun at the park shelter. Look for more info on the list. It usually occurs in the early evening after 6 PM.

**Pancake Breakfast** will be Saturday, September 10<sup>th</sup> at the Martin Park shelter from 7:30 to 11:30 AM. This is our annual fundraiser and you can make a donation for a ticket at the event.

Our community **Garage Sale** will be on **August 13-14th**. Mana will run an ad in the daily camera. Neighbors are encouraged to make their own signs and put them up at the ends of their street.

New Email List Update: In addition to having a new communications steering committee member, Ron DePugh, we have opened the e-mail list to noncommercial garage sale and other announcements of local Martin Acres service by residents

Announcements are limited to once per month for services. The policy is still a non-commercial use.

We've also had some discussions about setting the default to replying to the list or to the original sender. We have decided to keep the default policy to respond to the entire list. Martin Park: We continue to have volunteers from the area work on the Park. There was a ceremony and a few of our volunteers were invited to join them. This was part of a larger Tree City USA celebration and awarded to the city of Boulder.
