GET INVOLVED: BOULDER COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

This Fall, the City of Boulder is updating one of its most far-reaching area management plans: the Boulder Valley Comprehensive Plan. It will guide residential and commercial development, city growth rates, land use, transportation, and nearly every facet of our community. Martin Acres residents are encouraged to get involved. The next public input session is Mon., Sept. 26, 5 to 7 p.m. at St. Paul's Church, 4215 Grinnell Ave. They'll hear public input on possible development of CU's South Campus, and land use (zoning) changes at 385 Broadway (next to NIST) and the Table Mesa Shopping Center. CITY COUNCIL RE-VISITS CO-OP ORDINANCE OCT. 4

On Tues., Oct., 4, 7:00 p.m., at the Municipal Building, 1777 Broadway (SW corner of Broadway and Canyon), Boulder's City Council will hear, for a second reading, a proposed coop ordinance. Citizens wishing to speak must sign up in person, at the meeting, for public hearings like this. Citizen comments will be limited to 2 minutes per person.

The proposal would allow households to exceed Martin Acres' current occupancy limits for unrelated individuals. Council is exploring different square footage formulas for occupancy. The most recent one is 200 sf/person. Thus, a 1,000 sf house could have 5 unrelated individuals, and a 2,000 sf house (a ranch w/ full basement) could have 10 unrelated persons.

The proposed ordinance does not require such households to provide additional off-street parking.

As always, Martin Acres residents are encouraged to attend on Oct. 4 and speak, regardless of your position, on issues such as this which have direct bearing on our neighborhood.

RTD SERVICE UPDATE FOR MARTIN ACRES

After thirty years of planning, negotiating, and developing, this April RTD added a new airport service from Union Station to DIA: the "University of Colorado A Line." This commuter rail line runs every 15 minutes through the day, and 30 minutes during late-night and early morning hours. Importantly to us - RTD has no plans to discontinue its SkyRide AB routes. This means we now have multiple practical options for travel between Boulder and DIA.

The A Line features kiosks at Union Station where users can print airline tickets and drop-off baggage - allowing bypassing of check-in lines at DIA.

Along with adding the new airport route RTD has also changed the price of all airport routes (A-Line and SkyRide): a one-way fare is now \$9 (\$4.50 discounted for seniors, students and the disabled) and includes unlimited RTD service for the rest of the day. Additionally, owners of EcoPass or CollegePass can now access the airport routes without any additional charges.

These improvements make the Boulder-DIA trip via a Union Station transfer a viable alternative to the AB route. For most users the AB will continue to be the fastest and most convenient method of getting to DIA. But the since the A-Line extends the number of hours and frequency of trips, it will occasionally be the fastest or best 'back-up' option on the street.
