Transitioning to Fossil-Free Households in Martin Acres: A Dialogue with the City of Boulder – July 10

In 2016, the Boulder City Council passed Climate Commitment goals for the city. These goals include transitioning to an energy system and economy that utilizes 100% renewable electricity by 2030, with at least 50% produced locally.

Community climate action is also an essential component to reaching these goals. Moving your household towards fossil fuel free means better air quality in your home, savings on your energy bills and a healthier community overall.

Please join Martin Acres Neighborhood Association on July 10, 2017 at Church of the Nazarene, 5:00-6:30 p.m. for a presentation on the "nuts and bolts" of transitioning away from fossil fuels in our households. Thanks to all of our neighbors for the great turnout at MANA's annual EGGZTRAVAGANZA on April 15. We had 250 children and 100+ adults, raring to go at 9am in Martin Park. Our volunteers showed up at 7am to clean the area, set up for egg hunting, water balloon launching, egg on a spoon and sack races .We hid about 1200 eggs stuffed with candy. Every single egg was found! Thanks to Bridge House volunteers, MANA and our neighbor Silas for stuffing!

The most popular game was the water balloon launch skillfully run by neighbor Matthew Arnold and crew. MANA handed out \$10 Grand Rabbit gift certificates to the top 2 winners for both Accuracy and Distance categories. \$10 Grand Rabbit Gift Certificates were also given to the 1st place 6-person "egg on a spoon" relay team. The sack race went on all morning and the winner of each of 10 races was rewarded with a fancy, stringy rubber ball.
